Head Coach Ryan Brittle serves as camp director. Coach Brittle is in his 20th season coaching college baseball. During his coaching tenure he has coached two big leaguers, nine draftees, 21 professional signees, 11 All-Americans including four

Academic All-Americans, 64 All-Conference selections including five conference players of the year. Coach Brittle has also coached two scholar athletes, 18 Academic All-Conference, and two Big South Scholar Athletes of the Year.



Lew Kent joined the Ferrum athletics staff as Assistant Baseball Coach in January 2015. Kent previously served as Head Baseball Coach at NCAA Division I Radford University from 1995-2007 and played professionally from 1986-88 in the

Cleveland Indians organization.



Assistant Coach Ben Austin joined the Ferrum staff as a volunteer assistant in August 2017 and was elevated to full-time assistant coach in 2018. Austin played collegiate baseball at Wofford College from 2005-08 as an outfielder and pitcher. He has previous

camp experience at Ferrum, Wofford College, and University of North Carolina.
