Camp Director/Staff



Head Coach Ryan Brittle serves as camp director. Coach Brittle is in his 15th season coaching college baseball. During his coaching tenure he has coached two big leaguers, ten draftees, 21 professional signees, 11 All-Americans including four Academic All-Americans, 34 All-Conference selections including five conference players of the year. Coach Brittle has also coached two scholar athletes, 18 Academic All-Conference, and two Big South Scholar Athletes of the Year.



Lew Kent joined the Ferrum athletics staff as Assistant Baseball Coach in January 2015. Kent served as Head Baseball Coach at NCAA Division I Radford University from 1995-2007. Kent played baseball professionally from 1986-88 for the Cleveland Indians.



Assistant Coach Ben Austin joined the Ferrum staff as a volunteer assistant in August 2017 and was elevated to full-time assistant coach in 2018. Austin played collegiate baseball at Wofford College from 2005-08 as an outfielder and pitcher. He has previous camp experience at Ferrum, Wofford College, and University of North Carolina.
